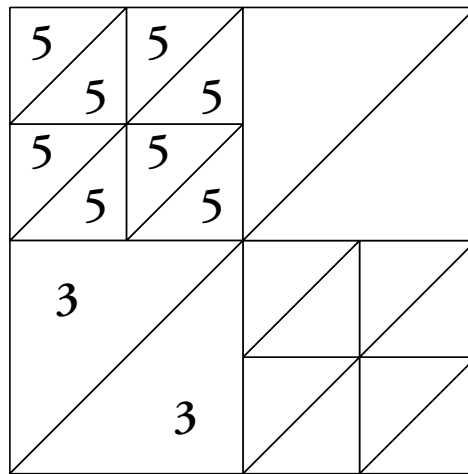




Flock of Geese

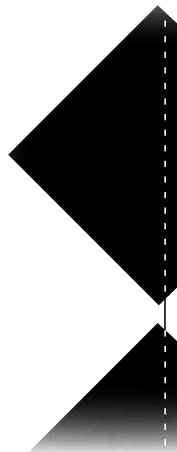


Rough Cut Chart for One Block

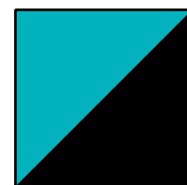
	6" Block	9" Block
	Two Large Triangles 4" x 5" First Medium 6" 55009 9" 55397	(1) 6" square First Medium
	4" x 5" Dark Layer right sides together. Layer cut.	(1) 6" square Dark Layer cut right sides together.
	8 Small Triangles (1) 3" x 10" Light 6" 55319 9" 55147	(2) 3½" x 7½" Light
	(1) 3" x 10" Second Medium Layer right sides together. Fold in half. Layer cut	(2) 3½" x 7½" Second Medium Layer cut right sides together.

Sewing Large Triangles

1. Assembly-line sew two sets of large Triangles right sides together.

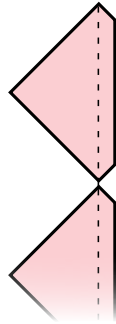


2. Set seam with dark on top. Open, and press toward dark.

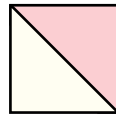


Sewing Small Triangles

1. Assembly-line sew eight sets of small Triangles right sides together.

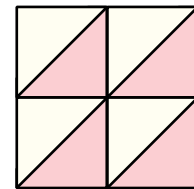
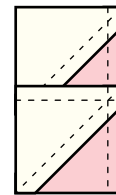
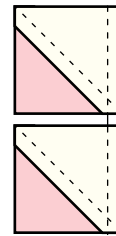
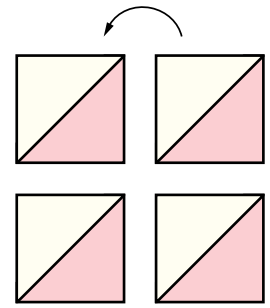


2. Set seam with dark on top. Open, and press toward dark.



Making Geese

1. Lay out two blocks.
2. Flip right sides together.
3. Assembly-line sew vertical row.
4. Turn. Push top seam up, and underneath seam down. Lock seams.
5. Assembly-line sew.
6. Clip thread loop in center.
7. Lay block flat, wrong side up.
8. "Swirl" seams counter clockwise.
9. Press from right side.



Sewing Block Together

1. Lay out pieces.
2. Flip right sides together. Sew vertical row.
3. Turn. Press center seam up, and underneath seam down. Sew remaining row.
4. Clip center loop of thread.
5. Push top seam up, and underneath seam down. "Swirl" center clockwise.
