This pattern is a supplement to *Magic Mountain Quilts* by Quilt in a Day.

This Wallhanging shows four rows of Mountain blocks in four different sizes. The first row has three large Mountain blocks in the foreground, with each row getting progressively smaller in the distance. Far away mountains at the top of the Wallhanging appear less vivid in intensity. Dusk is approaching with the setting "Sun." It is reminiscent of the enchanted Mountains of New Mexico. A light snowfall has created a sparkly mist of snowflakes.

Making Mountains

1. Cut out and label all pieces following Yardage Chart on back page.
2. Cut pieces for Mountains one row at a time.
3. Sew Mountains together following basic directions on pages 18-20

Row 1 Three Mountains

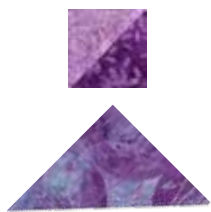


Dark Peaks (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
 Light Peaks (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
 Dark (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
 Mountains (1) $4\frac{3}{8}$ " x 21"



Light (3) 3" squares

Row 2 Three Mountains

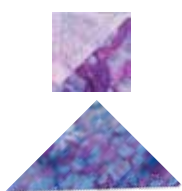


Dark Peaks (2) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $9\frac{3}{4}$ "
 Light Peaks (2) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $9\frac{3}{4}$ "
 Dark (3) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
 Mountains (1) $4\frac{1}{8}$ " x 17"



Light (3) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

Row 3 Three Mountains



Dark Peaks (2) 3" x 9"
 Light Peaks (2) 3" x 9"
 Dark (3) 3" squares
 Mountains (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15"



Light (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Row 4 Two Mountains



Medium Peaks (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 11"
 Light Peaks (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 11"
 Dark (2) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
 Mountains (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "



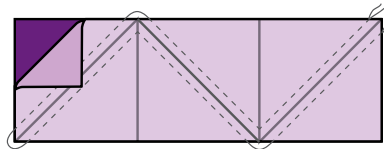
Light (2) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares

Making Sun

Follow directions for Star on pages 11-13, using Triangle in a Square Ruler. Do not set on point.

Light and Dark Peaks

Place Light and Dark Peaks right sides together. See page 5 for sewing in *Magic Mountain Quilts* pattern.



Pair Light and Dark Peaks.
 Square to twelve 3" squares.
 Cut on one diagonal.
 Line up $6\frac{1}{8}$ " line with $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
 Triangle Square Up Ruler.
 Cut three triangles. See page 3.

Pair Light Peaks and Dark Peaks.
 Square to twelve $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.
 Cut on one diagonal.
 Line up $5\frac{3}{4}$ " line on $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
 Triangle Square Up Ruler.
 Cut three triangles.

Pair Light and Dark Peaks.
 Square to twelve $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
 Cut on one diagonal.
 Line up 5" line on $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Triangle
 Square Up Ruler.
 Cut three triangles.

Pair Light and Medium Peaks.
 Square to eight $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
 Cut on one diagonal.
 Line up $4\frac{1}{2}$ " line on $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
 Triangle Square Up Ruler.
 Cut two triangles.

Setting Rows Together

1. Row 1: Setting Triangles (1) 11" square. Cut on diagonal.



Corners
(1) 8¼" square

Sew three Mountains and Triangles together.

2. Row 2: Setting Triangles (1) 10" square. Cut on diagonal.

Sew three Mountains and Triangles together. Add Extender to left side. Sew to Row 1, lining up right edges. Trim left edge even with Row 1. Press seams toward Row 1.



Corners
(1) 7½" square

Left Row Extender
7" x 5"

3. Row 3: Setting Triangles (1) 9" square. Cut on diagonal.

Sew three Mountains and setting triangles together. Add Sky corners and Row Extenders. Sew to top of row 2. Press seams toward Row 2.

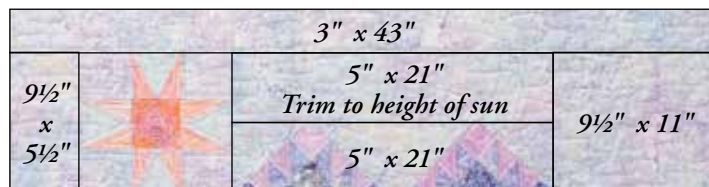


Sky (1) 6¾" square for Corners

(1) 6¼" x 6¾" Left Extender

(1) 6¼" x 3¼" Right Extender

4. Row 4 Sky Setting Triangle (1) 8" square. Cut on diagonal. Discard one half.



Folded Border

1. Piece together three 1⅛" strips. With wrong sides together, press in half lengthwise.
2. Lengthen stitch and use less than ¼" seam. Sew Folded Border along two sides and top edge.








Finishing

1. Piece together (3) 5" Border strips, and sew to two sides and top edge. Piece together one and a half 8½" Ground strips. Sew to bottom edge of Mountain.
2. Layer, quilt, and bind.
3. Optional: With invisible thread, sew patches of transparent snowflake fabric on top of quilt. Embellish with beads.

Making Trees

1. Fold each felt rectangle in half lengthwise. Cut on diagonal to make a triangle. Randomly cut out triangular points on each side of tree.
2. Decorate with water color pencils and crystals. Glue trees to quilt with appliqué glue.

	Five Spruce Trees	1/4 yd White Glitter Felt	7 1/2" x 4 1/2", 4 1/2" x 4", 6" x 5", 8" x 5 1/2", 5" x 3 1/2"
	Optional		Hot fix crystals, beads, or water color pencils. 1/4 yd Transparent fabric with foiled Snow Flakes
